About the Speakers

Here is some background information on the invited speakers and what they may be able to cover in their talks.

If possible please keep in mind that the programme details above are outlines at this stage; the visiting Artists may vary their content on the night based on the presentation material they select or in response to Qs from Cavan Artists who attend.

Michael Fortune's contemporary practice works in a range of areas including Visual Art, Traditional Arts & Music and Public Commissions. Michael will talk about the realities of working from his studio in rural Co. Wexford. He will aim to discuss creative ways to develop your practice including online and artist-led initiatives. Michael's talk is titled 'The King of Intangible Culture'.

Katherine Atkinson is a musician and also works in the area of Project Support and Professional Development with Create, the national development agency for collaborative arts. Katherine will explore public engagement in contemporary art using examples from the Create Artist in the Community Scheme (AIC) including artists project which collaborate with the unemployed, examine cultural diversity, and work with parents and kids, young people and teenagers.

Justine Foster works as the Education and Community Coordinator at Uillinn: West Cork Arts Centre where she develops projects with a range of communities of interest including parents, children, young people and older people, as well as exploring cultural diversity and Arts + Health practice.

Val Ballance is the Head of Venues and Touring at the Arts Council of Ireland. Val will focus on touring opportunities in <u>all artforms</u>, building an audience, cross-border touring opportunities and networks for presenting projects.

Participants must then a short presentation with 20 images set on an auto-timer for 20 seconds each. The presentation can be on anything relating to your practice – research, a new idea, artwork, documentation of a project – anything you wish to present openly that you think will be of interest to your peers. Again slots will be allocated on a first come, first served basis and the first 7 Cavan Artists to sign up for the Pecha Kucha slots will be sent a presentation template to use to prepare their material. The Artists Exchange sessions will include an opportunity for a Cavan Artist to run a Workshop in any artform. The workshop must be practice-based, suit the 45 minute time slot and be feasible in the venue. Please email a proposal, maximum 400 words of what you want to do and why, your CV and relevant documentation of previous work – video clips and/or audio files, images, etc. The selected artist will be paid a fee and will be facilitated by the Curators in Residence. FAQ

What is PechaKucha?

Frequently Asked Questions PechaKucha Nights are informal and fun gatherings where creative people get together in a public place and share their ideas, works and thoughts in a relaxed way. Most people use PechaKucha Night to present their latest creative projects or work. Good PechaKucha presentations are the ones that uncover the unexpected -- unexpected talent, unexpected ideas. Some PechaKuchas tell great stories about a project or an experience. Some are incredibly personal, some are incredibly funny, but all are very different – and FAST!

The fee of €20 for all three sessions, what does this cover?

The fee goes towards drinks, snacks and Visiting Artists travel expenses.

What if my practice needs less professional development and more help with artists events, is it worth going along to these sessions?

Yes, we think so. It will be a chance to meet other Cavan Artists and Practitioners, present your work at PechaKucha or promote an event in the Elevator Pitch timeslot. The speakers have been chosen to reflect the needs and feedback from the Cavan Artists who took part in the Hello Sessions with the curators. There is also an opportunity to run a creative workshop.

What if I can't attend the sessions, is there a way that I can access information?

The curators have invited a writer to collaboratively document the sessions, and any links, opportunities and deadlines mentioned will be made available to artists on the Arts Office and Curators mailing list. Please email cavancurator@gmail.com to join the mailing list.

Will the sessions be suitable for people working in any artform?

The sessions have been programmed to reflect the ideas and interests presented to the curators in the Hello Sessions. The speakers work in different artforms and/or contexts, so it is hoped that their information will be useful to artists regardless of artform. The call for Cavan Artists to present a Creative Workshop will also be an opportunity for Cavan artists to address particular areas of interest.
